Should: Wh-question

- How did you label each category?

What should I do?

Who should I call?

Wh-question + modal + SUB + Base form of verb

Should: Wh-question

- Go over ONLY **A** with your partner.
- See if you agree with it or disagree with.
- Go over **B** with your partner.
- Find out one similar point and one different point that you found.

Should: Yes/No question

- What is Yes/No question? Any examples?

Do you like it?

Did you do your homework?

Should: Yes/No question

- How did we make Yes/No question for present perfect?
- How do we make Yes/No question for "should"?

Should: Yes/No question

- Should I buy this car?
- Should I find a new job?
- Should I start doing homework for this week?
- I have lots of works to do but should I visit my best friend from high school this weekend?
- Should I go to San Diego to see my best friend?
- Should I buy a new laptop?

Can we use ought to in Question...?

NO

Intonations

A: Should I buy this car?

B: No, you shouldn't buy a new car.

A: Do you think I should find a new job?

B: Yes, you should if you want to.

**Any differences in two sentences?
Pay attention to the intonation patterns.**
